

BSRC Inter-Club Match Report - 12th October 2013.

The day got off to a great start with bright sunshine streaming across the range which was a welcome surprise considering the miserable meteorology on Friday and the shocking forecast for Saturday. Attendance was good with 11 teams and 37 shooters representing most of the regular teams to a greater or lesser degree. On the subject of participation, it has come to our attention that the invitation is not reaching all the parts (Affiliated Clubs) that it should. Heinekin and computers don't mix so we'll review and update the list manually in time for the Spring 2014 match.

Congratulations are due to Addlestone who finally made it to the top of the podium, partly due to performance (one point short of their best score of 992.5 of October 2011) and partly due to a depleted BDS A team who were missing a couple of their usual gunslingers. The BSRC ROs gave them a run for their money while also organizing and running the event and cooking lunch for everybody; next jobs are world peace and the UK economy! The BSRC Old Stagers' were either inspired by the return of their leader, or else put some new batteries in their pacemakers to restore the pulse to their score; nice score sheet by the way – obviously got too much time on their hands.

Overall the team scores showed some improvement over May 2013. The Deer was down from 259 to 258; Boar up from 182 to 190; Stalkers' Test down from 275 to 272; 10m Running Target up from 158 to 170. This gave an average team aggregate score of 891, 18 points up on May 2013.

NB1: Deer scores are doubled and Boar scores halved to roughly equalize the HPS's. The scores shown are those of the best (aggregate) or only three in each team.

NB2: We have taken pity on the 'Nots' SCA and multiplied their two-man score by 1½ to compensate for their third team member who did 'Not' turn up.

The top three individual scores (HPS = 420) were 372.5 (Alan Harvey, BDS A), 367 (Alistair Bullen, BSRC ROs) and 360.5 (John Kynoch, BSRC Old Stagers). In case you were wondering how well you did as an individual, the average scores for the Deer (doubled), Boar (halved), Stalkers' Test and 10m air rifle were 82, 63, 87 and 55 respectively, giving an average individual aggregate score of 286.

Although I forgot to raise the issue of manning the BBQ in the invitation, no team stepped forward to volunteer (noting that Addlestone and Chelmsford have recently done a turn). Since the present situation is unacceptable on a permanent basis, we are looking at buying in some help with the catering. This may result in a modest rise in the entry fee, although this has remained at £15 for as long as I can remember and probably overdue a rise anyway. Otherwise, and in the absence of a volunteer, it will be packets of crisps all round next time apart from the ROs who will sit down to a three-course silver service lunch so there!
