

## BSRC Inter-Club Match Report - 14th May 2016.

A whopping 14 teams containing a total of 53 shooters entered which is the largest attendance since I took over organizing these matches in 2007, and probably a record. Both Boar ranges were working and splitting the Baxter (slow runs on the Mid Boar and fast runs on Time Limit Boar) seemed to work well – at least I didn't hear any complaints about queuing. To be honest, this was a case of making a virtue out of a necessity (we were having technical problems with fast runs on the Mid Boar), but we will probably continue with this format.

A brand new team, The Cernunnos (Celtic “horned god” apparently – oer!) descended to Earth and nicked first place with a respectable 984, followed by Addlestone (back from hols in Scotland) with a decent 955.5 and Chelmsford B hot on their heels in third place with a not too shabby 954. By the way, in case you were wondering, a Teckel (one of The Nots teams) is basically a sausage dog!

As regards the average team scores: the Deer was down from 252 to 235; Boar down from 180 to 173; Stalkers' Test down from 269 to 267; 10m Running Target up from 141 to 155. The overall effect was an decrease in the average team aggregate score from 841 last October to 831.

NB: Deer scores are doubled and the average of the Boar slow and fast scores taken to roughly equalize the HPS's. The scores shown are those of the best (aggregate) or only three in each team.

The top three individual scores (HPS = 420) were 362.5 (Keith Cox, Aldershot RPC – where did he come from!), 360 (Terry Ord, Addlestone) and 358 (Darren Cottee, Chelmsford B). In case you were wondering how well you did as an individual, the average scores for the Deer

(doubled), Boar (average), Stalkers' Test and 10m air rifle were 75, 53, 87 and 50 respectively, giving an average individual aggregate score of 265.
